R=Requirements



- Provide the charter fees
- Provide an active Kiwanis Advisor and have them meet with the Faculty Advisor and Principal at the beginning of each year
- Protect yourself, use the rule of three with everything. That includes texts, phone calls, emails, in person meetings and virtual meetings
- Review Youth Protection Policies
- Have a background check through Kiwanis International

O=Opportunity



- Take the chance to train them in their officer positions, on how to plan service projects, and how to run meetings
- Give them the opportunity to lead
- Let them fail (within reason)
- Let them experience leadership

C=Collaboration



- Remember when to step back and let them lead
- Include them in planning projects and events.
 - They have excellent ideas and a unique insight.)
- Let them produce and create ideas for project and events.
- Remember when to step up.
- Invite them to all your Kiwanis functions

K= Kinship

- Get to know them!
- Ask them about: their hobbies, their post high school plans, why they joined a service organization, and many other things.
- You will find things in common, but you have to ask
- They are afraid to ask you too!
- Consider sharing information about you, they want to relate to you.

I= Inspiration



- Every student has something that inspires them, work on finding that!
- Tell them what inspires you!

- Appreciate and celebrate their successes
- You can inspire them!

N= New

- It's a whole new world!
- Find ways to do things virtually and together!
